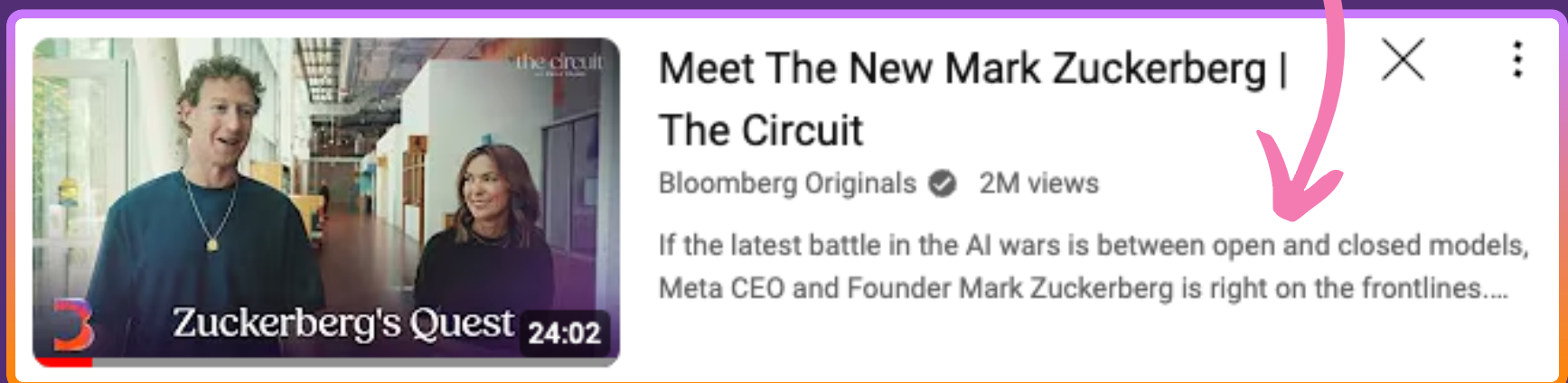

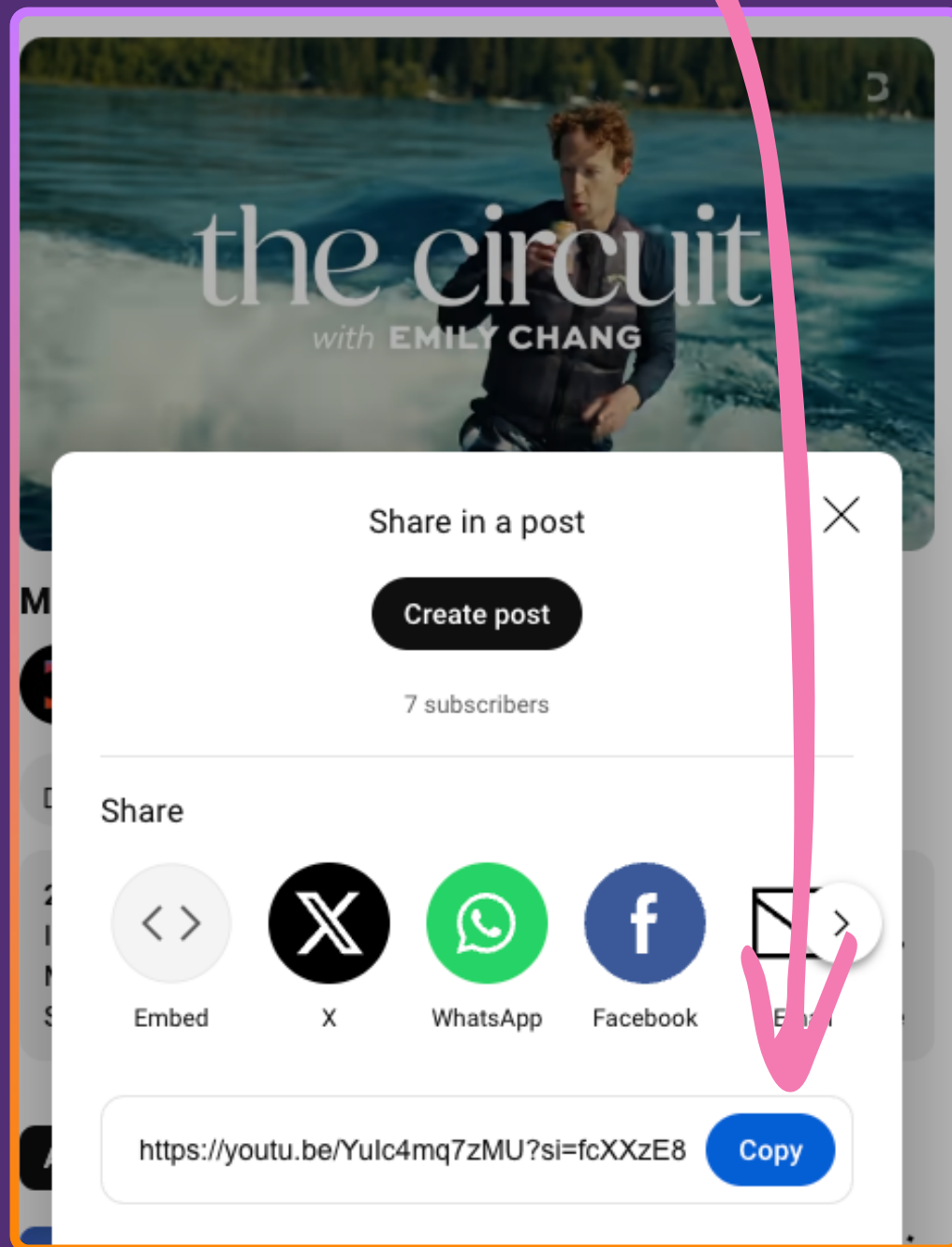
Choose a YouTube Video

Copy YouTube video URL

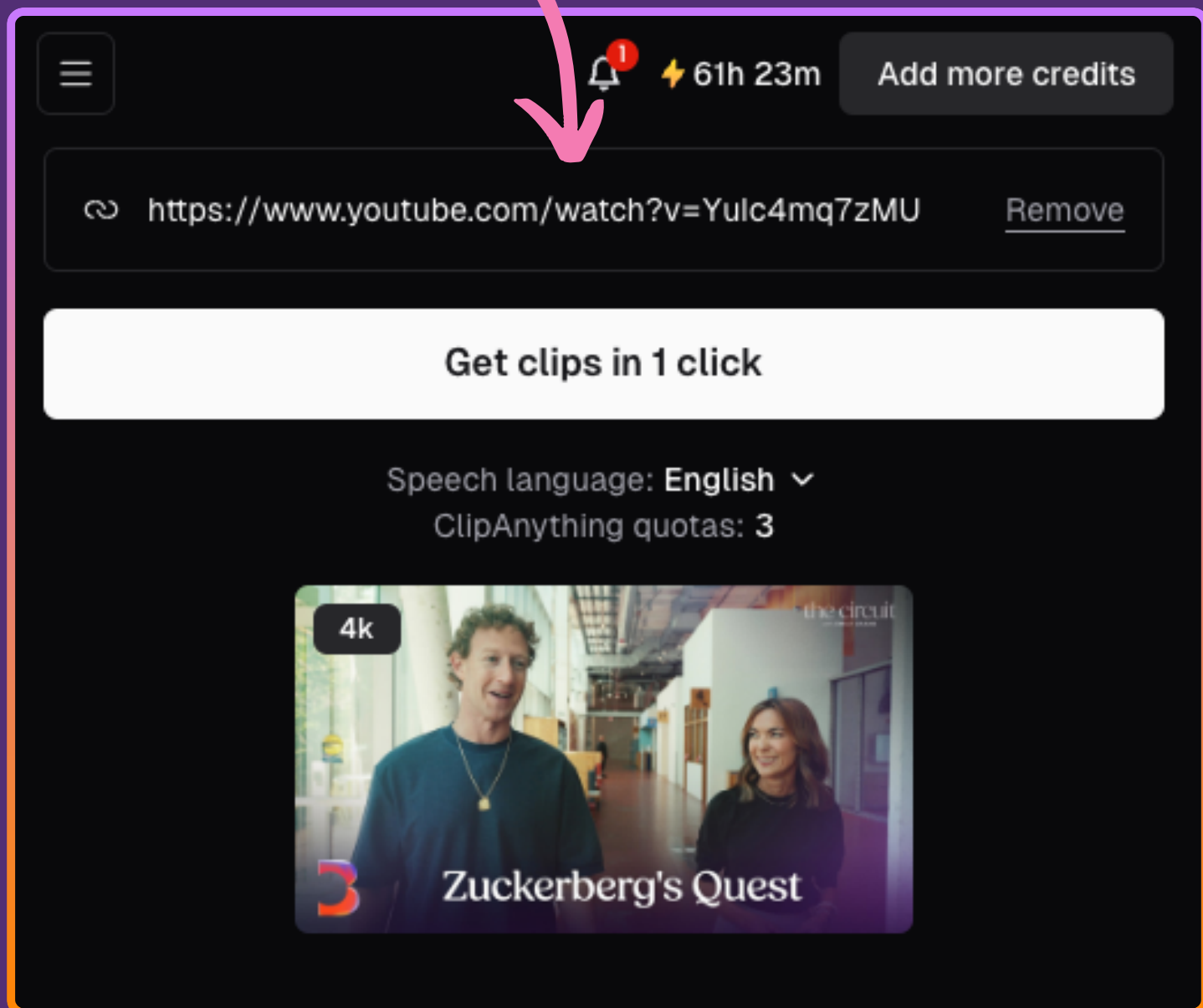

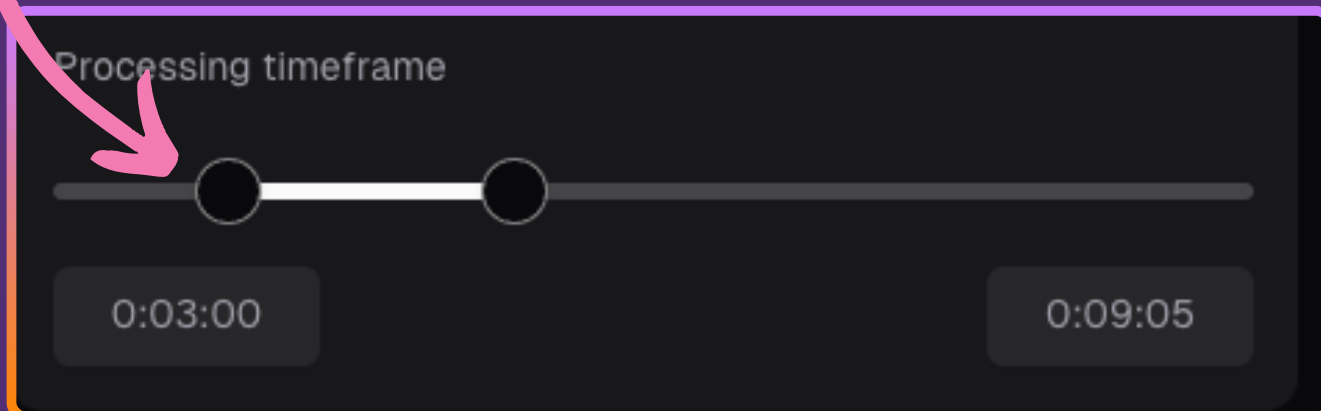
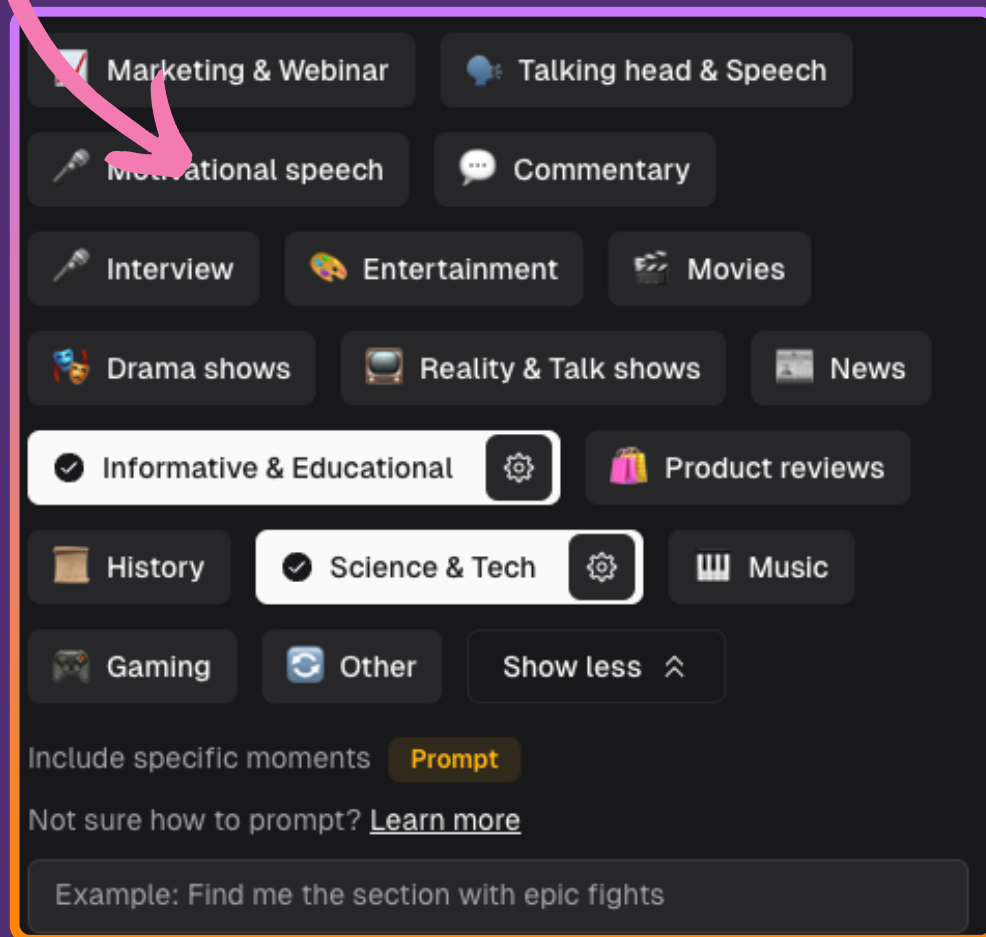

4: Select Section

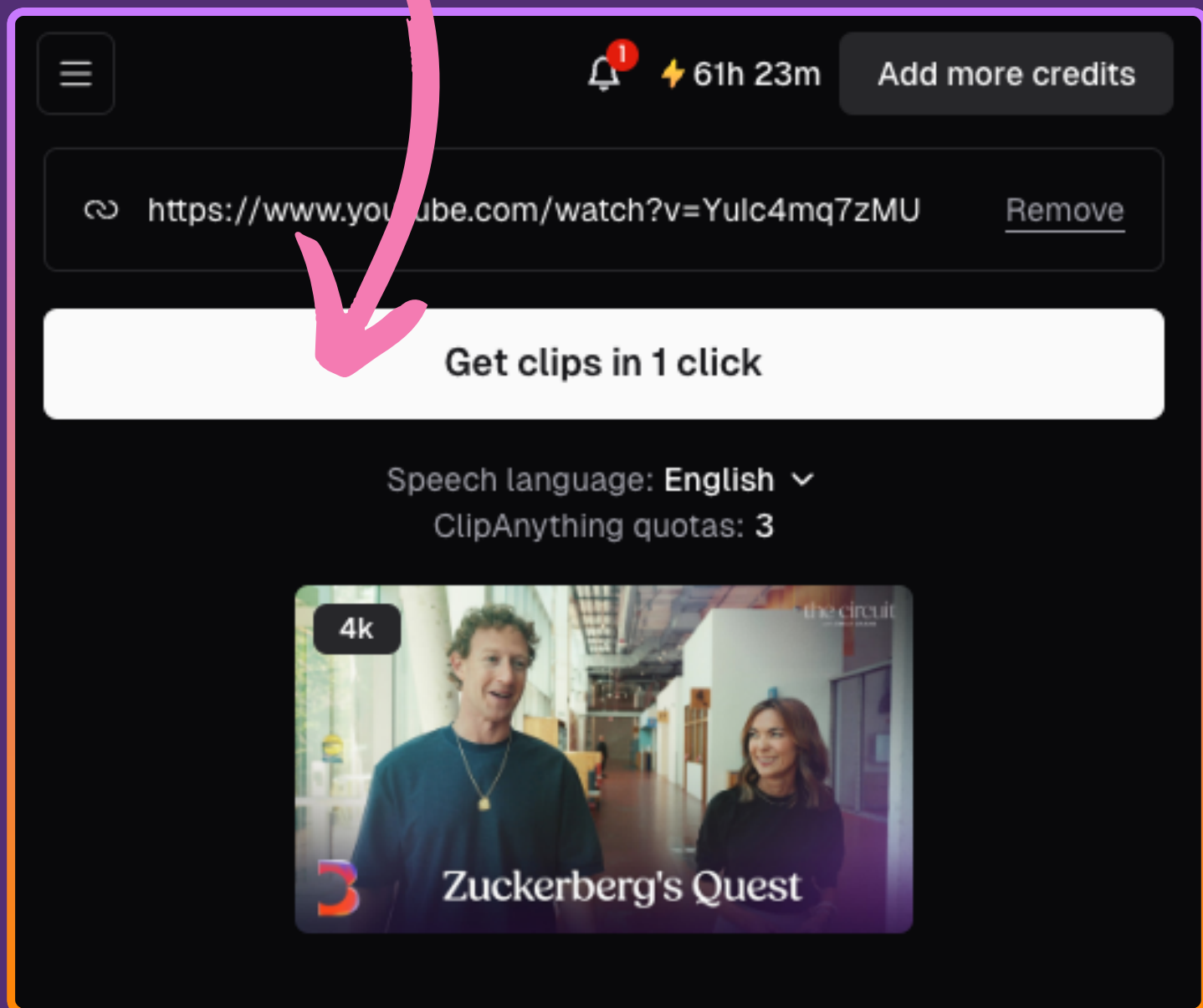
Select genre & video section

5: Get Clips

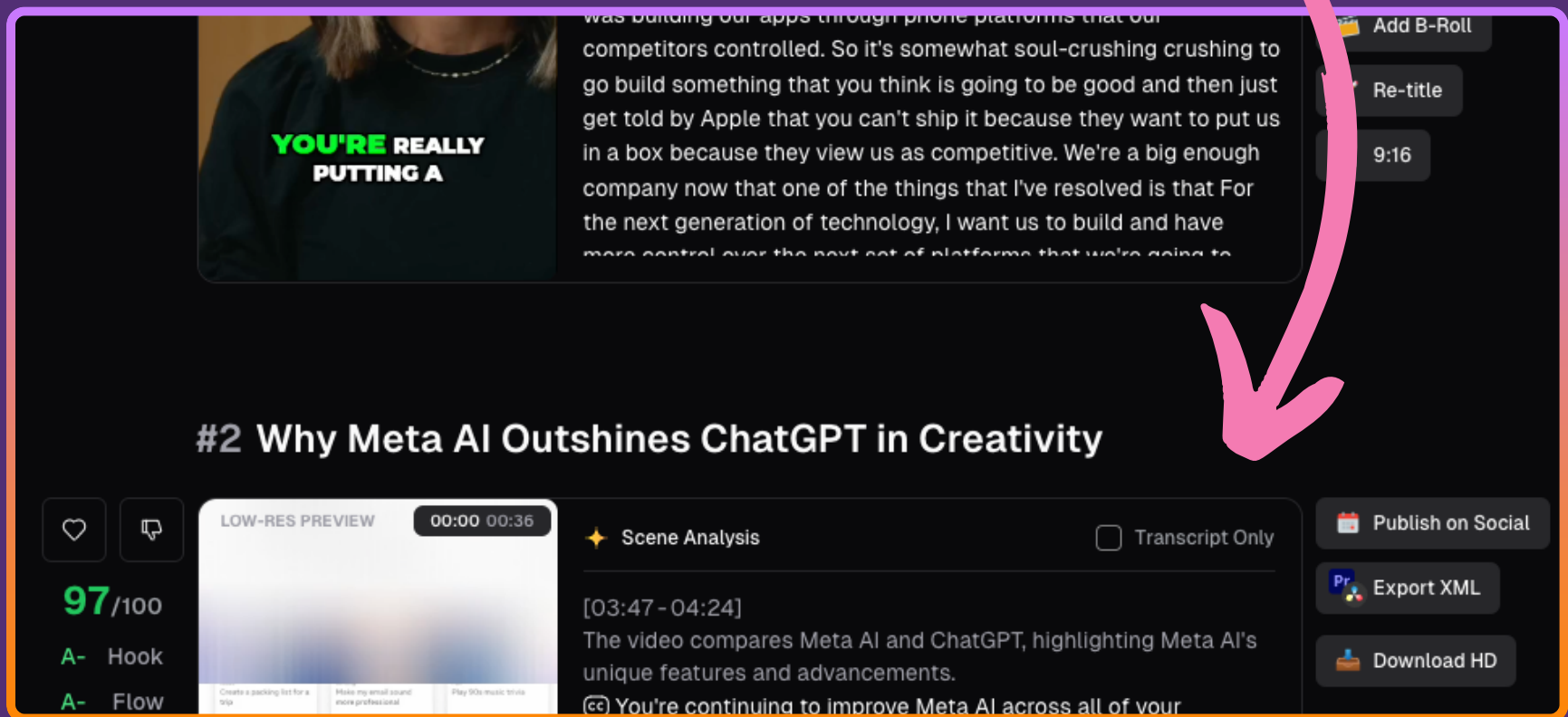
Generate clips from your vid

6: View Clips

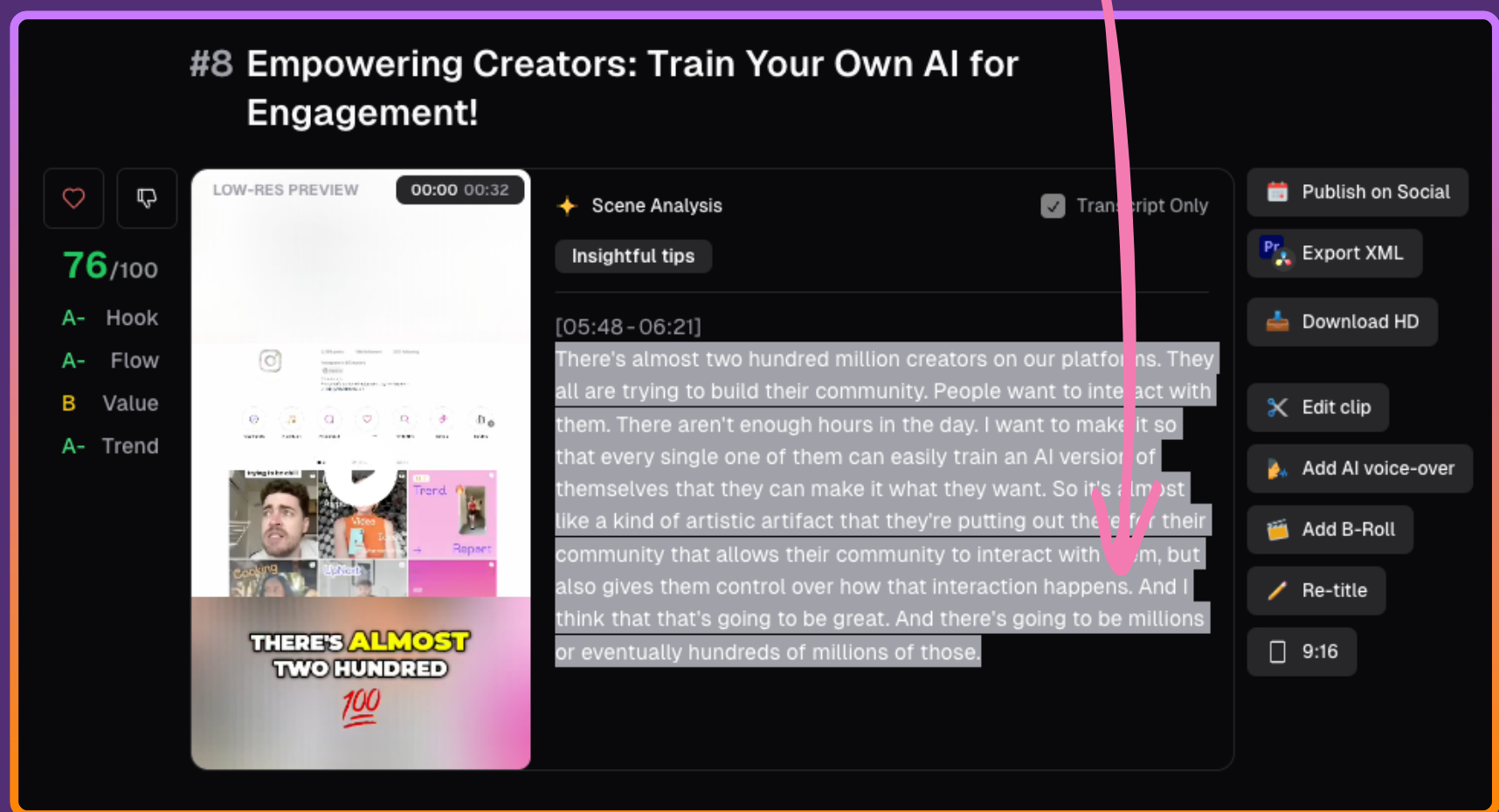
